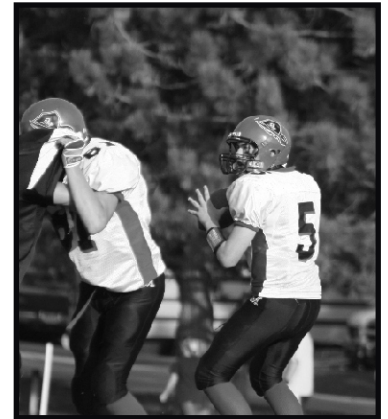

Nate Raver's junior season turned out to be the tops through the air in Raider football history. Raver broke nearly all of the passing records during the 2008 season. One of the most impressive numbers is Raver's 1894 yards through the air, and to add to his remarkable yardage numbers he also posted 23 touchdowns with 140 completions.



Josh Moline ended his career at Mead as the most prolific passer in school history. Moline set and still holds nearly all of the passing records for the Raiders.
