On Thursday, April 25, Dr. Mark and Joni Adler will share the story of their son Reid, who committed suicide at age 15. After Reid's passing, the Adlers discovered that he was the victim of intimidation and cyber bullying. In *Reid's Story*, the Adlers share their family's experience and challenge students to stand up for each other and stop bullying or inappropriate treatment between students.

Grades 7-12 will attend the presentation. However, because of the sensitive nature of the content, parents may choose that their student(s) not attend.
